PARSHAT TETZAVEH, YEAR 3

Shemot (Exodus) 29 ³⁸Now this is what you shall offer* upon the altar: two yearling lambs each day, tamid[†]. ³⁹You shall offer the one lamb in the morning, and you shall offer the other lamb at twilight. ^{‡ 40}There shall be a tenth of an *ephah* of choice flour with a quarter of a hin** of beaten oil mixed in, and a libation of a quarter hin of wine for one lamb; ⁴¹and you shall offer the other lamb at twilight, like the morning's grain offering you shall do it as a pleasing fragrance to יהוה, ⁴²a burnt offering tamid throughout the generations, at the entrance of the Tent of Meeting before יהוה. For there I will meet with you, and speak to you there.

⁴³And I will meet there with the Israelites, and it shall be consecrated through My kavod.^{†† 44}And I shall consecrate the Tent of Meeting and the altar, and I will consecrate Aaron and his sons to serve Me as priests. ⁴⁵I will abide^{‡‡} among the Israelites, and I will be their God. ⁴⁶And they shall know that I am יהוה God, who brought them out from the land of Egypt that I might abide among them.  $30\,^{1}$ You shall make an altar for burning incense; make it of acacia wood. 2 It shall be a cubit long and a cubit wide— it shall be square— and two cubits high, its horns of one piece with it. 3 Overlay it with pure gold: its top, its sides round about, and its horns; and make a gold molding for it round about. 4 And make two gold rings for it beneath its rim; make them on its two side walls, on opposite sides. They shall serve as holders for poles with which to carry it. 5 Make the poles of acacia wood, and overlay them with gold.
